**Message from Mrs Lewis** This week Pembrokeshire County Council has published a new set of proposals regarding the reorganisation of secondary school education in Haverfordwest. The proposal is to close Taskers and STP and open one new school, with a Sixth Form, in September 2018, using the existing buildings and sites at first, with a view to move to new or refurbished buildings in the future. The consultation is open until 28<sup>th</sup> February and everyone is encouraged to fill in a response form. Although you may have expressed your views previously, this is a new consultation so previous responses will not be considered.

## English Medium Secondary Education Provision in Haverfordwest

Following its consideration and subsequent refusal of previous proposals, the Council is now considering a new proposal for English medium secondary education provision in Haverfordwest:

- Close Sir Thomas Picton School and Tasker Milward VC School on 31st August 2018
- Establish a new 11 - 19 English medium school in Haverfordwest with effect from 1st September 2018, initially utilising both existing school sites
- Designating Johnston CP School and Neyland CP School as feeder schools to Milford Haven School. Extending the catchment area of Milford Haven School to encompass the catchment areas of Johnston and Neyland

**We would like to hear the views of all involved before making a decision on whether or not to proceed.**
