

School Rules



The School Rules are designed to make our school a productive and rewarding place for everyone who works here.

- We must act with courtesy and consideration to others at all times. Good behaviour in class and around the school is essential.
- In the interest of everyone's safety, people should move quietly and in an orderly manner around the school. Keep to the left in corridors.
- Everyone must arrive on time for registration and lessons. All pupils need written permission to leave a lesson or to leave the school premises at break or lunchtime.
- Pupils must wear the correct school uniform every day. Hair colour and style must be appropriate. (Please contact school if you are unsure of what is acceptable.)
- Pupils may wear no earrings other than one unobtrusive pair of ear studs. No other jewellery (including body piercing, make-up or nail varnish) is allowed.
- Pupils are requested to respect the buildings and all school property, including books. Loss or damage to property may be charged to parents. Any accidental damage should be reported immediately to a member of staff. Litter should always be placed in bins.
- Other people's property must be treated with respect. Lost property should be handed in to one of the offices.
- Expensive items of personal property must not be brought to school. This includes personal entertainment equipment and mobile telephones. School cannot be responsible for any loss or damage.
- Dangerous items such as laser pens, penknives and aerosols are not permitted. Pupils are not allowed to smoke and under no circumstances should drugs or alcohol be brought onto the school premises.
- Leave all medication at the school office. Bring a letter from home to explain what the medication is for and when it needs to be taken. The School Nurse, Mrs J Phillips will be informed.
