Extra notes:

Art (Year 7)

The poster is to include the slogan '**When you come home again to Wales!**' Pupils to look at the work of Welsh artists for inspiration - these might include Peter Prendagast, Aneurin Jones, Kyffin Williams, Ogwyn Davies.

History (Year 7)

Your artefact should be from a specific period of History. It should be something that helped people in their daily lives e.g. a Roman comb, an Egyptian mummy, a Medieval cooking pot, a Tudor toothbrush, a Victorian train or a 20th Century gas mask

History (Year 8)

Your event should be historically accurate. It could be the Roman invasion of Wales, a Medieval spring fete, a Tudor Christmas, the Great Exhibition in the Victorian era, the coronation of the Queen or man landing on the moon. You should include images, flags, and words to add as much detail as you can

Geography (Year 7)

A good example would be a picture of Bee flying around the number 10 = TENBY. The cleverest and best designed win.

Science (Year 8)

Examples could include Hydroelectric or Wind Power, Refineries, Aerospace (in North Wales), Nuclear power (Anglesey), steel making To be considered they must include details of where in Wales their choice is, how long it has been there, how many people work there etc.

Maths (year 8)

Create a poster/leaflet about the Welshman that invented the = sign. Include a little about him and interesting examples of the = sign being used.
