Dear Parent/Carer,

Tasker Milward School Disruption – Industrial Action

I am writing to inform you that the National Association of Schoolmasters Union of Women Teachers (NASUWT) have balloted for strike action in response to a trade dispute over school closure with potential restructuring, job loss and changes to working practices.

Three days of strike action are planned:

Tuesday 12th June
Thursday 28th June
Wednesday 11th July

While not all teachers will be taking industrial action, for Health and Safety reasons, it will not be possible to open the school to pupils, with the exception of those below:

- **Pupils taking external exams on Tuesday 12th June will not be affected.** All school buses will run as normal for these pupils, a quiet place to revise in the morning will be provided before they sit their exam at 1pm. The canteen will be open to provide refreshments at break and lunchtime for these pupils.

For pupils sitting the History GCSE exam in the afternoon, we will be providing History revision workshops in the morning. The canteen will be open to provide refreshments at break and lunchtime for these pupils. All school buses will run as normal.

- For any pupils sitting their GCSE Chemistry exam on Wednesday, 13th June, there will be an additional revision session from 9:00am until 11:00am on Tuesday. The canteen will be open to provide refreshments at break and lunchtime and the school buses will run as normal.

The Local Authority and Temporary Governing Body of Haverfordwest High VC School will continue to work with the Union to resolve this dispute. In the event of the planned strike on 11th July taking place, we will need to reconsider the arrangements for the planned Year 6 transition day. Further details will follow.

In the event of the industrial action being called off then I will update you via text, website and our pupils.

May I thank you in anticipation of your co-operation.
